PREPARING FOR HOLY WEEK



Holy Week is the most sacred time in the Christian year. During these days, the Church walks with Christ through the final events of His earthly life—His Passion, Death, and Resurrection. Through prayer, scripture, and sacred ritual, we enter into the mystery of our salvation and prepare our hearts for the joy of Easter.

PALM SUNDAY | MARCH 29TH (8am Saint Barbara, 10am Saint Mary)

Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem as the crowds welcomed Him with palm branches and cries of "Hosanna!" The liturgy also proclaims the Passion, reminding us that the path to glory passes through the Cross.

TUESDAY, MARCH 30TH & WEDNESDAY, MARCH 31ST of Holy Week

These days invite us to quiet reflection as we prepare for the Triduum. On Wednesday, the Stations of the Cross help us prayerfully reflect on Christ's journey to Calvary.

The Easter Triduum

The three sacred days of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil form the heart of the Church's year, celebrating the mystery of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

HOLY THURSDAY | APRIL 2ND (7pm Saint Barbara)

We remember the Last Supper, when Jesus gave us the gift of the Eucharist and the priesthood, and taught us humility through the washing of the feet.

GOOD FRIDAY | APRIL 3RD (12 Noon Saint Mary, 3pm Saint Barbara)

We solemnly remember Christ's suffering and death on the Cross. Through the veneration of the Cross, we unite our lives and struggles with His sacrifice.

HOLY SATURDAY | EASTER VIGIL MASS | APRIL 4TH (8pm Saint Mary)

Beginning in darkness and moving to light, the Easter Vigil celebrates the Resurrection of Christ and the new life given to us through Baptism.

EASTER SUNDAY | APRIL 5TH (8am Saint Barbara, 10AM Saint Mary)

We rejoice in the Resurrection of the Lord, the victory of life over death and the source of our hope.

We invite all parishioners to join us in these sacred celebrations as we journey together from the Cross to the joy of Easter.

Dear Parishioners,

This 2025-2026 school year, we have navigated unique challenges, including the need to downsize due to a lack of qualified teachers in our area. Despite these changes, our commitment to excellence remains firm. Operating now with only our middle school, we are proud to provide a curriculum that balances tradition with innovation.

Morning Core Academics: Students focus on essential subjects in the morning hours to ensure strong foundational learning.

Afternoon Exploratory Blocks: In the afternoons, our students engage in Multi-Disciplinary, Project-Based Learning. These units vary week to week, allowing students to dive deep into diverse topics through hands-on experience. These include food safety and cooking, cleaning and organization, sewing, music appreciation, health and physical education, varied art forms, and **Secure in Grace**, a curriculum from the Dominican Sisters that invites students to know and participate in their own neurodevelopment, in a virtuous life, and in the lives of the saints as our heroes and models of faith.

Interpersonal Communications: We have introduced this course to specifically teach critical thinking for better decision-making. It is designed to equip our students with the social, collaborative, and organizational skills they will need for their future success.

With the success of this initiative, we will expand this opportunity in 2026-2027 to all **third through eighth-grade** children and families who value a more holistic approach to education. If there is sufficient enrollment for **Kindergarten-second grade**, we will reopen these grades as well.

We believe that nurturing each of these areas helps students grow into confident learners, compassionate leaders, and faithful members of their communities.


