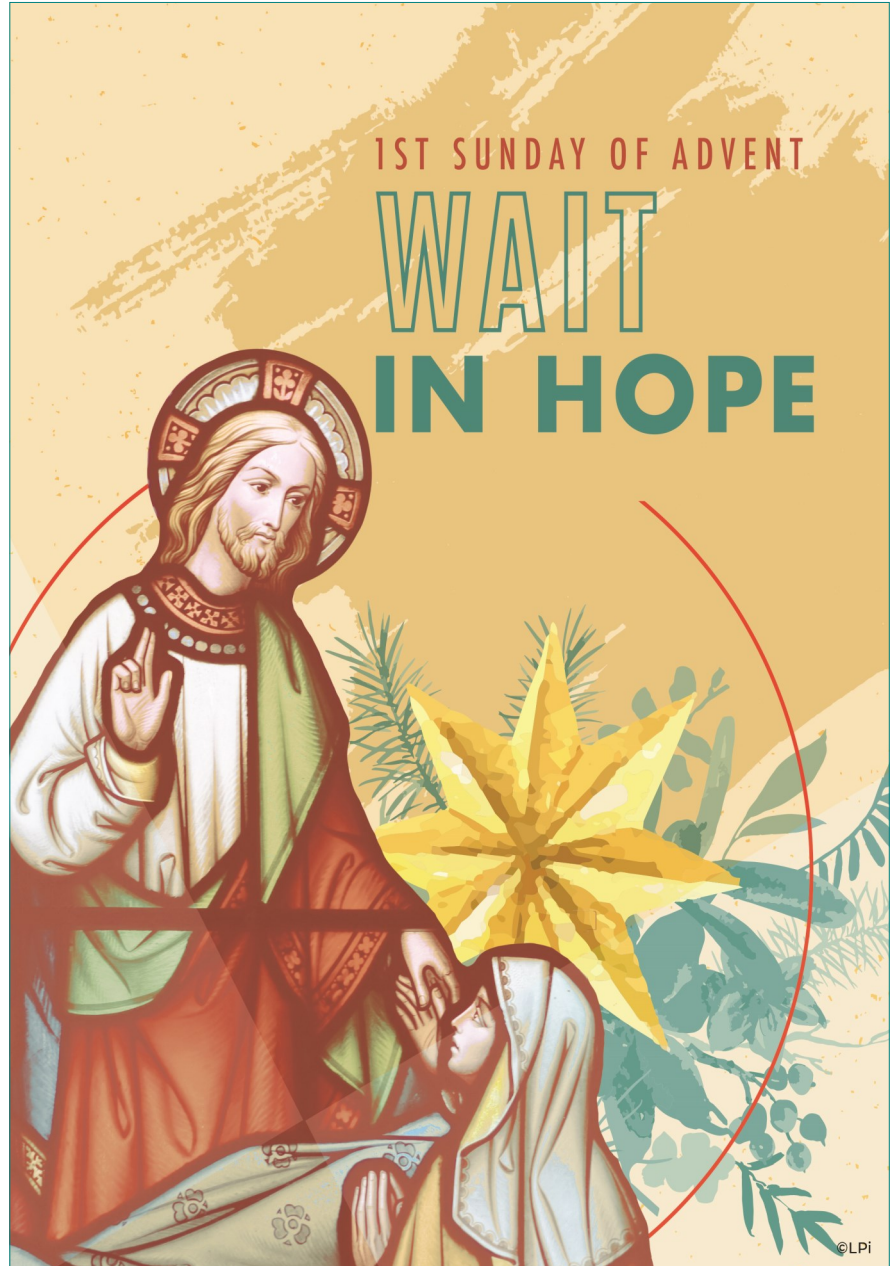

### Norway SVDP Prepares for the Holidays

As we prepare our hearts and homes for the coming of the Christ Child during this wonderful season of giving, St. Mary and St. Barbara Conference continues to prepare for the needs of those less fortunate. This past fiscal year (Oct.1, 2024--September 30, 2025) we were able to provide over \$42,547.00 of assistance for utility bills, rent, prescriptions, food, shoes for back-to-school, and other necessities. The number of individuals and families in need of assistance has increased significantly since last year. In addition, we spent \$1,556.00 on additional conference and operating expenses.

The conference office for assistance is available on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday from 9-11 a.m., or by special appointment if needed.

Monetary or food donations may be brought to us at anytime, Monday thru Friday from 9:00am to 3:30pm.

During December we will need **canned kidney beans** or **chicken noodle soup** and **toothpaste**. Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. **Note: The pantry and store will be closed during the Christmas holidays from December 22 through January 2, and re-open on January 5.**

We are truly appreciative of the ongoing monetary or pantry donations which have made such a difference in the lives of so many people and hope your continued generosity and prayers will help to provide for those in need.

### A note from Fr. Abraham

Advent is a time of patient waiting in expectation of the Lord's birth. Just as we prepare our homes and our family life for the celebration of Christmas, so too we should be preparing ourselves spiritually – beginning today – to celebrate the birth of the Savior.

The season is about re-discovering Christ within ourselves. Advent is a time to be more aware of Christ's presence in our search for healing and reconciliation in the midst of human brokenness and division.

Like the presence of Christ, our ministry of presence is far more precious than all the presents we can give those whom we claim to love and care.

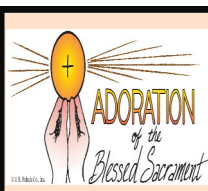
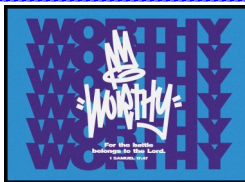
Registration is open and filling quickly for the next **Steubenville North Youth Conference** held in St. Paul, MN. This year's dates are, **July 24th-26th.**

Students need to be going into their freshman year to attend. This is a great opportunity to fulfill the retreat requirement for Confirmation!

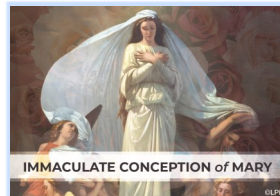
The cost of the trip is \$525, but thanks to the Legacy of Faith Grant each participant receives a \$50 discount, bringing the total cost to \$475 per person.

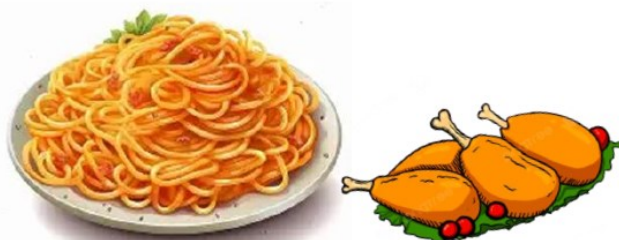
