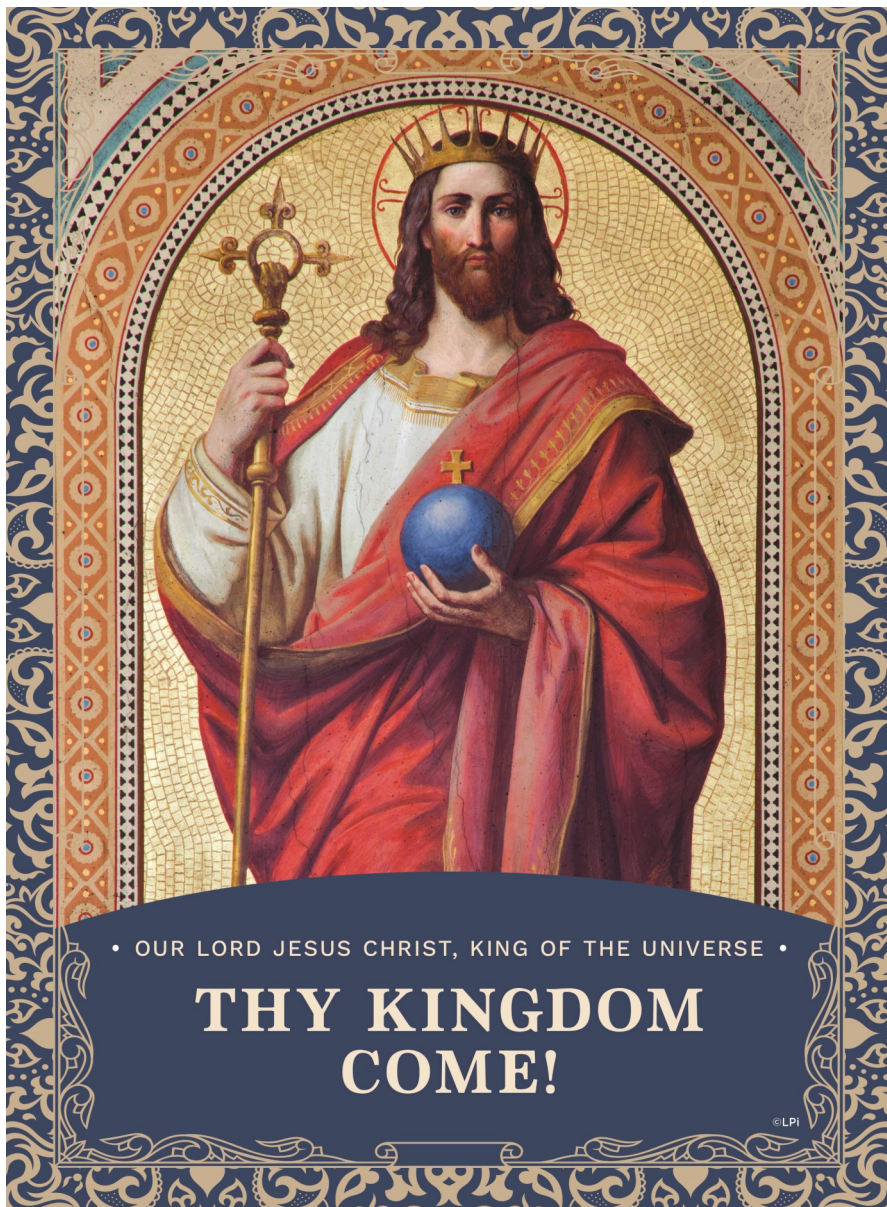

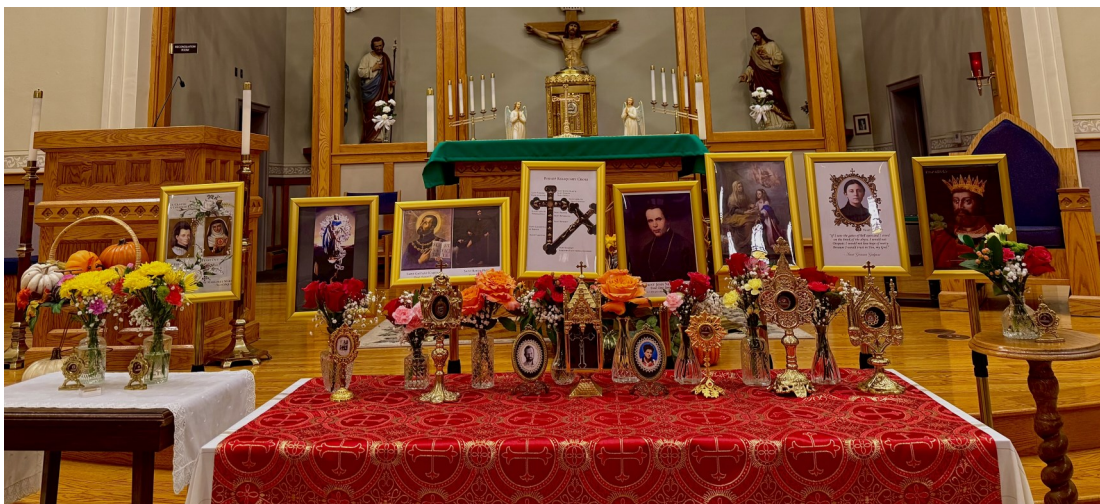
All profits go to fund the annual Coats For Kids program. Free jackets are provided to any child that needs one in our area.
