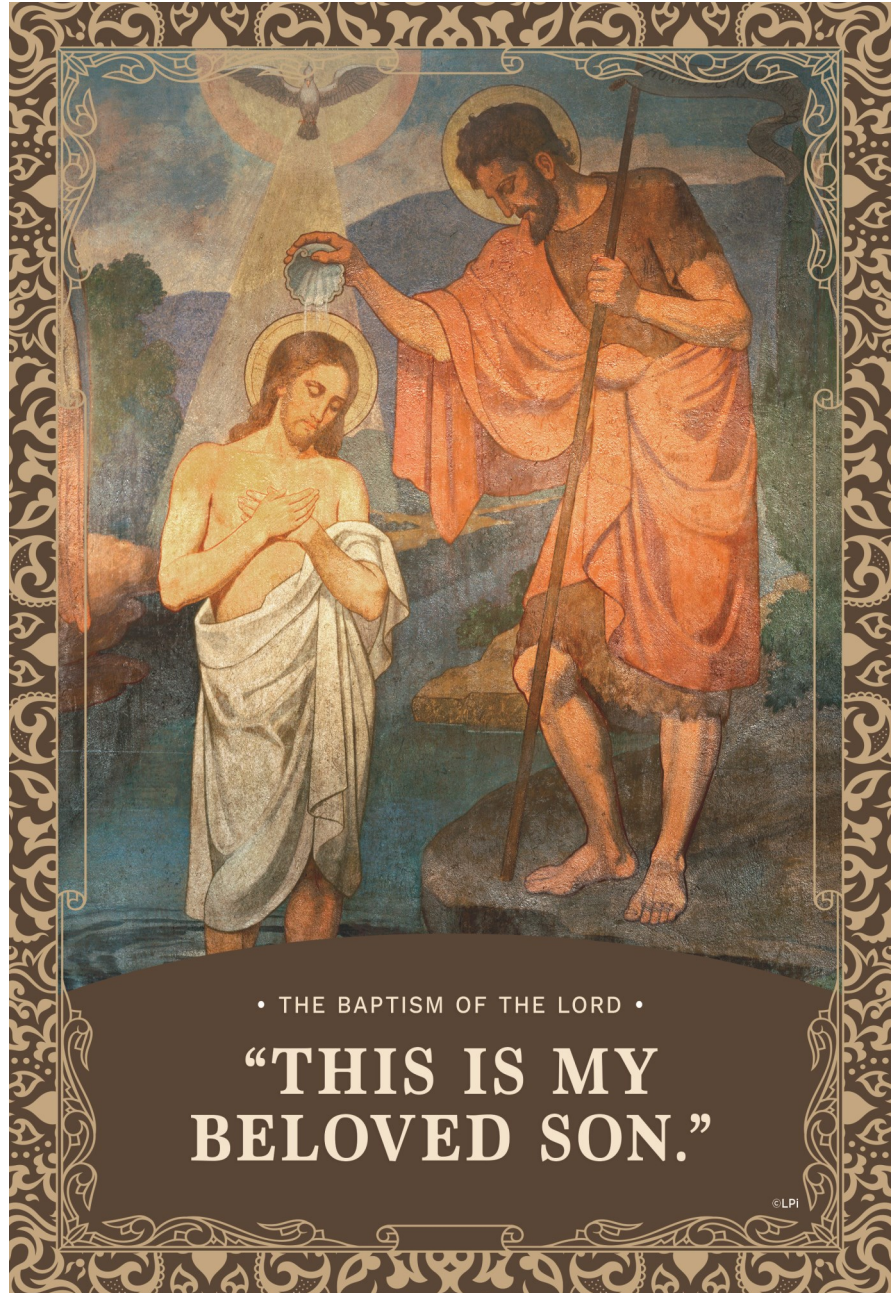

A note from Fr. Abraham

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This weekend, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Lord's Baptism by John in the Jordan River. As Jesus emerges from the water, a voice is heard. That voice is that of God, the Father. He proclaims: "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." These are the words that were distinctly heard as Jesus emerged from the water after John had baptized Him. Who among us would not love to hear these words? To hear that we are beloved children of God would be enough to warm our hearts and shatter any darkness that may surround us.

Liturgically, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord brings the Christmas season to a close. It transitions us from the celebration of Jesus' birth to the contemplation of His mission and ministry. The readings and prayers of the day emphasize themes of renewal, purification, and the call to discipleship. The feast invites us to reflect on our own baptismal promises and the implications of being baptized into Christ.

As we celebrate this feast, let us recall the day of our own baptism and renew our pledge to live faithfully as a member of God's chosen people.

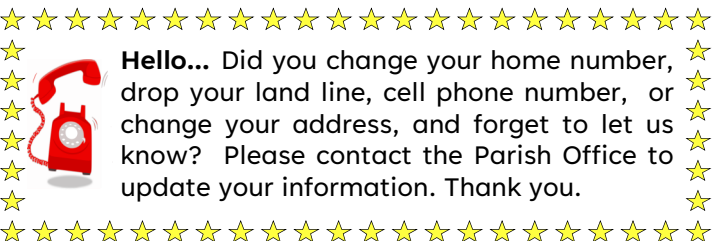
