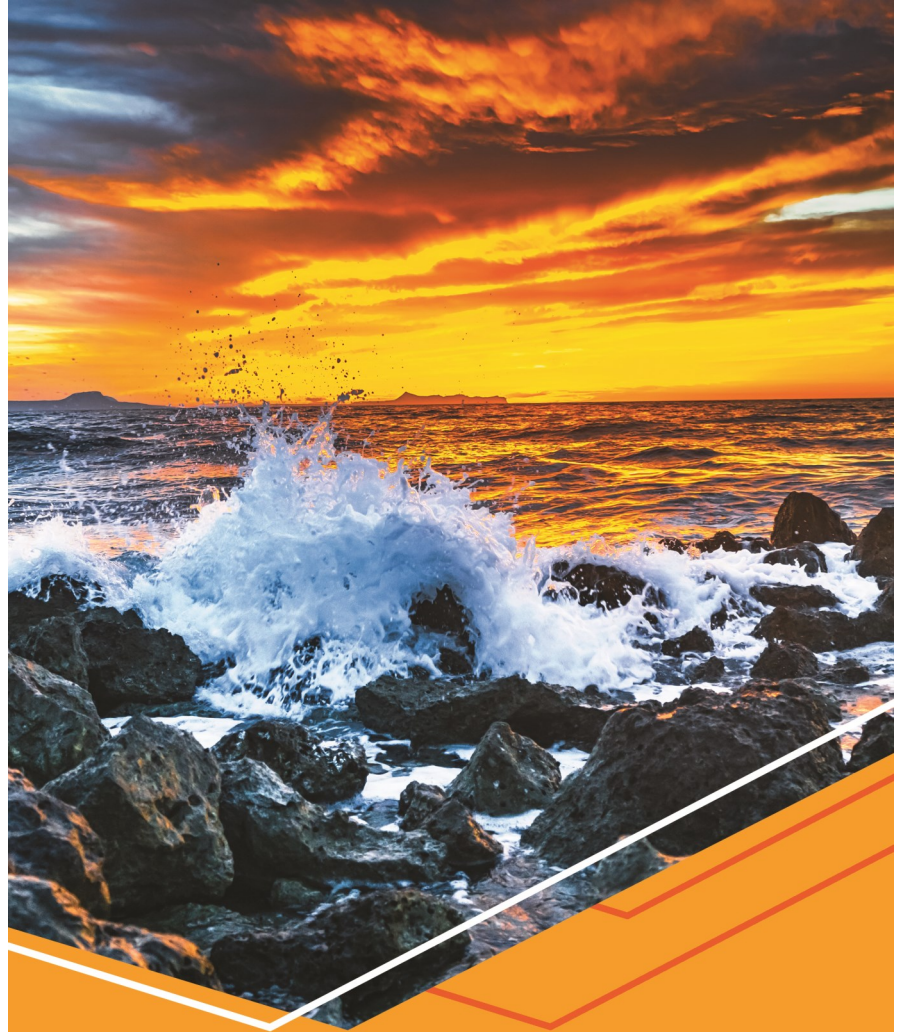

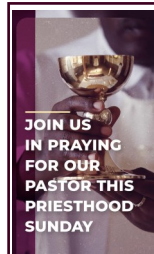

- existential crises of spirituality or identity

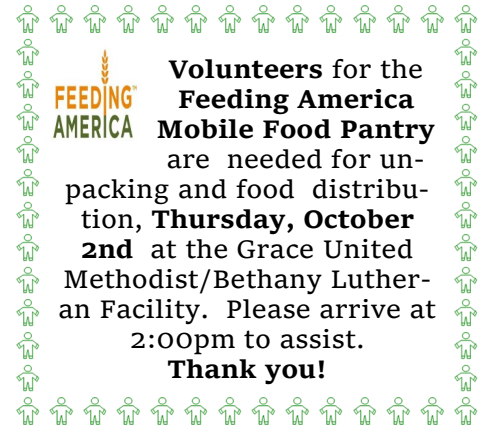

- Return Home after March (bus will stop at a restaurant on the way home for dinner - self pay)

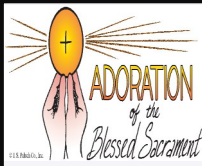

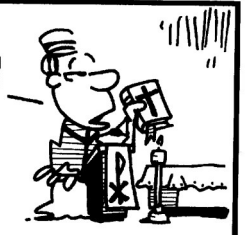

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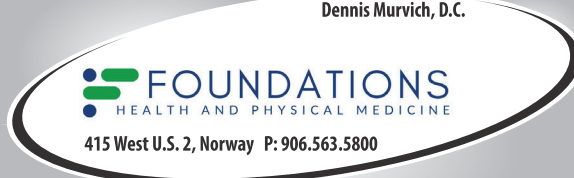
