## Divine Mercy Sunday

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

In a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Today, we know that feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, named by Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000.

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us—all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. In this way, all will come to share His joy.

The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

**A – Ask for His Mercy.** God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

**B – Be merciful.** God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

**C – Completely trust in Jesus.** God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

The Divine Mercy Sunday Celebration for our Vicariate will be held at **Saint Mary & St. Joseph Parish, Iron Mountain** this Sunday. It will begin at 1:00 PM with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and conclude with praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 3:00 PM followed by Benediction. 7 priests will be available for confessions from 1:00 PM to 3:00PM. Please plan to attend this beautiful celebration of Divine Mercy.

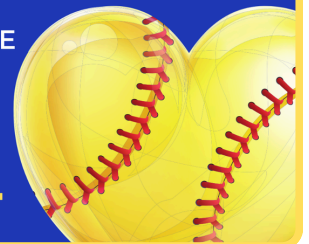
