



My dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

Let me introduce myself to you. I am Fr. Abraham Mupparathara MCBS and I am going to be your new pastor starting from July 1, 2025. I am from Kerala, India. I was ordained as a priest on December 26, 1994. I belong to a Religious Congregation known as Missionary Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament (MCBS). My previous priestly appointments include Secretary to the Superior General of MCBS, Spiritual Director in the Minor Seminary, Superior and Pastor of 2 MCBS Houses and Parishes in Kerala.

I came to the United States in 2001 and was the Associate Pastor at St. Paul the Apostle Church in Calumet, Our Lady of Peace Parish in Ahmeek, Our Lady of the Pines Missions in Copper Harbor, Holy Redeemer Missions in Eagle Harbor and at St. Pater Cathedral in Marquette. In 2003 I was appointed as the Pastor of Sacred Heart Church in Calumet and in 2006 appointed the Pastor of St. Paul the Apostle Parish in Calumet, Our Lady of Peace Parish in Ahmeek and the Keweenaw Missions while retaining role as Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish in Calumet. In 2019 I was appointed as the Pastor of Holy Spirit Church in Menominee and in 2021 Pastor of Holy Redeemer Parish in



Birch Creek in Menominee while retaining role as Pastor of Holy Spirit Parish in Menominee.

Change is a constant part of our human experience, and while it may often seem uncertain or even unsettling, it also presents us with a profound opportunity to grow closer to God. The Lord does not abandon us. When we embrace change as a gift from God, we allow ourselves to be transformed by His grace. Whether we face a new challenge, a loss, or a new beginning, we are invited to trust in His providence. God is present in every moment of our lives, especially during times of transition.
